Haiti Mission Trips

Week One: Jacmel & Les Cayes

Departs: Friday, June 15
Returns: Saturday, June 23

Week Two: Jacmel

Departs: Friday, June 22
Returns: Saturday, June 30

Two Weeks: Three Teams

We will have three teams serving in Haiti over two weeks. The first two teams will travel to Haiti together and return together. A third team will arrive the second week to serve in Jacmel.



The **Les Cayes Team** will be staying at the "Children of Israel" Orphanage in Torbeck. They will be working at the orphanage, leading a Vacation Bible School, and teaching other classes.

The **Jacmel Teams** will be working with LCMS World Relief and building new homes for Haitians who have been living in tents since the earthquake. Other projects may include working to support a local orphanage.



Requirements

You must have a passport and all immunization shots in order to travel to Haiti. You will also need to attend all the Haiti Mission Trip Prep Meetings to prepare yourself for what you will

experience. These trips are extremely challenging for any student or adult.

Transportation

We fly to Miami on the first day and then to Port-au-Prince the next day. The return trip home is completed in one full day.

Lodging and Meals

The first night, we'll stay in a hotel in Miami. When in Haiti, we will stay at a local guest house and receive three meals a day.

Cost

The registration fee for Haiti is \$450. This covers your meals in Haiti, lodging, travel insurance, and local ground transportation. It does not cover any passport fees, immunization costs, or your airfare. Airfare is estimated to cost \$650.

The Work

We will partner with North Dakota's Lutheran Disaster Response as we help families who lost their homes during last year's flooding. We expect to work on demolition of vacant homes and repair and restore other homes in Minot.

Transportation

We will be traveling by 15-passenger vans. The vans will be driven by adults over 25.



Lodging and Meals

Lodging and meals in Minot will be coordinated by Our Savior's Lutheran Church.

Other Activities

We'll be stopping in Minn/St. Paul, MN on the way out to Minot, ND. We'll enjoy some local activities both there and in N.D., too!
